



# Guidelines & Additional Info

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## ANY SPECIMEN CAN BE REFUSED

This means any animal or part of animals that is damaged beyond repair or is potentially damaged WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All specimens shall have a license number and or tag number attached with specimen no exceptions. This includes status numbers and or Metis tags they are required on specimens that are taken under ones hunting or trapping privileges.

Trapped specimens brought in must have trappers license associated with animals.

**ALL ITEMS LEFT ARE AT OWNERS RISK AND I AM NOT LIABLE FOR NATURAL DISASTERS OR ANY UNCONTROLLABLE CIRCUMSTANCES WHILE IN MY POSSESSION.**

This includes house flooding, or forest fires, house fires or any freak accidents that may occur.

Road kill and electricity strikes can be accepted if the individual has a POSSESSION LICENSE FROM CONSERVATION which is a \$20 fee and 28 day wait to confirm that they are allowed to bring it in and have taxidermied. Conservation will have to keep animal until approved permit is given. Before giving it to them make sure animal is not super damaged or shot. If shot a permit may not be issued to individuals and specimens can not be taxidermied.

## PAYMENT /INVOICING

50% Down-payment required on all orders before starting a project and I will have project completed with in 6 months of receiving item. Rest of balance due on pick-up.

If after 30 days of completion and no payment is made item is legally mine and small claims court may commence.

If extra work is needed to repair on current item brought in more fees may/will apply. For example; you bring a bear pelt in and paws were chopped off and I have to sew back on there will be a repair fee of 35 dollars per hour.

A \$100 bio-hazard surcharge may be applied to total INVOICE if any specimen is in a liquid or maggot stage when brought to me. Frozen or fresh animals are best way to preserve specimen.

Some species I work on shall be posted on-line on my portfolio or photo gallery for a show case of work completed.
